What to Bring to Camp

- Bible, pen or pencil, notebook (1st & 2nd graders will not need a notebook)
- Modest** recreation clothing, swimsuit, pajamas
Please NO Short shorts, sagging pants, bikinis, miniskirts, spaghetti straps, or low cut tops. Please help us keep the camper's focus where it should be. We appreciate your support on this very important issue.
- Jacket/Sweatshirt (it cools when the sun sets)
- Shoes - flip flops may only be worn at the pool.
- Pillow and sleeping bag or blankets
- Flashlight (new or extra batteries)
- Wash cloth, towel, personal items (toothbrush, soap, shampoo)
- Sunglasses, sunscreen, insect repellent
- Any medications - **in original containers**, with written instructions on dosage and times given. These will be turned into the camp nurse at registration.
- Optional: Money for missions and the camp store. This is to be turned in to the assigned camp financial person at registration and will be given to camper as needed.
- Optional: camera & film, baseball glove

Cove Christian Camp is not responsible for lost or missing items.

What NOT to Bring to Camp

Drugs/alcohol, cigarettes/tobacco products, weapons/knives, fireworks, pornographic material. The Camp Director or Camp Manager has the right to confiscate and hold anything considered harmful or inappropriate.

Mail: Due to the shorter camp this year, all mail for campers will need to be given to the director upon arrival to the camp.
